On the Canopy Tour, you'll guide yourself through 10 separate platforms, complete with rickety bridges, spider nets, swinging platforms, tightropes and a heart-pounding 40-foot free fall. For thrill seekers, the Challenge Course features spine-tingling elements that are more difficult, including a quick drop that's 55 feet up in the air.
